A proud moment was reaching the National Final of the WorldSkills Accounting Technician competition, placing in the top 8 out of 200+ teams Balancing work and study was tough at first—I even failed an exam—but with support and a plan, I've passed every one since. I now feel like a confident and valuable member of the team".

Support and Culture.


