
One of Thomas' highlights was completing a screw pull with an engineer just weeks into the job, despite initially feeling overwhelmed by the unfamiliar machinery.

Their guidance has been key to his development, and the warm welcome he received made him feel part of the team from day one.

## **Looking Ahead**

Thomas is aiming to build on the foundation of his current apprenticeship and skills gained here at Prisma by continuing his professional development through further qualifications. He hopes to progress onto a Higher National Certificate (HNC) in Engineering, deepening his technical knowledge and expanding his career options. Alongside this, he's also keen to undertake an electrical installation course to strengthen his practical skills and broaden his expertise across disciplines. These next steps reflect his commitment to continuous learning and his ambition to become a well-rounded, highly capable engineer. We asked Thomas what advice he would give to someone who was starting an apprenticeship...

"My advice to anyone starting an apprenticeship is to make the most of every opportunity—whether it's a training course, a chance to learn from others, or simply observing how things are done.
